A.A. provides information to health care professionals on how best to overcome some of the misconceptions they or their patients often have about A.A., such as that A.A. is a religious organization or that they will be "judged" by those they meet in A.A.

A.A. has no affiliation with any particular religion and does not inquire about religious beliefs-or lack thereof-of alcoholics who turn to A.A. for help. . of recovery

However, A.A.'s program of recovery is based on certain spiritual values, and individual members are free to interpret these values as they see fit. to interpret these values as they see fit, or not to think about them at all.

Anonymity

Will people find out that I've joined A.A.?

Anonymity is and always has been a basic principle of the A.A. program. Most members, after they have been in A.A. for a while, have no particular objection if word gets out that they have joined a fellowship that allows them to stay sober. But no one has the right to break another member's anonymity.

This means that the newcomer can come to A.A. with the assurance that no new friend will violate the confidences of his or her drinking problem.
