AREA 87 DELEGATE'S REPORT



Brochure **explained**: Is A.A. for You?

This pamphlet includes a list of 12 questions to ask yourself if you think you may have alcoholism. Each question is followed by a short explanation to help you answer it. Experience has taught us that if we answer YES to four or more questions, we are in serious trouble with our drinking.

Excerpt: *Have you ever felt that your life would be better if you did not drink?* Many of us started to drink because drinking made life seem better, at least for a while. By the time we got into A.A., we felt trapped. We were drinking to live and living to drink. We were sick and tired of being sick and tired.
